Joan Oty Moran International Travel Scholarship

This scholarship supports international travel by students in the WVU Davis College of Agriculture, Forestry and Consumer Sciences who are regularly enrolled undergraduate students in the Interior Design Program. The recipients shall have demonstrated (a) need for financial assistance as determined by the WVU Office of Financial Aid and (b) a record of high academic achievement as determined by appropriate officials of the College. All scholarships will be awarded in the memory of Joan Oty Moran.

Mary Lou Schmidt Memorial Fund

A one year scholarship may be awarded to a freshman majoring in the Division of Design & Merchandising. Recipients must demonstrate financial need and show high academic promise with a minimum high school 2.5 GPA. All awards will be presented in memory of Mary Lou Schmidt. Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the WVU Extension Service.

Pearle E. Johnson Scholarship

An annual scholarship will be provided to "home economic" students within the WVU Davis College of Agriculture, Forestry and Consumer Sciences and the College of Human Resources Education. Recipients will be selected by the Dean of the College.

Phi Upsilon Omicron Scholarship

The nation honor society in Family and Consumer Sciences offers its members a variety of undergraduate scholarships and awards. Graduate students may apply for fellowship opportunities. Scholarships are awarded annually at the discretion of the organization.

Rachel Colwell Scholarship

One award is presented annually to a second semester sophomore, junior or first semester senior in the Division of Design & Merchandising who has maintained an overall 3.0 GPA. Preference is given to a student member of Phi Upsilon Omicron. Scholarships are awarded annually at the discretion of the organization.

Ruth E. Weibel Memorial Scholarship

Scholarships awarded in the name of Ruth E. Weibel will be provided to undergraduate or graduate students in the Division of Family and Consumer Sciences who have an emphasis in textiles and clothing. The recipients shall have demonstrated a) need for financial assistance and b) high academic promise as determined by appropriate officials of the Office of Student Financial Aid and the WVU Davis College of Agriculture, Forestry & Consumer Sciences.

WV Association of Family & Consumer Sciences Scholarship

Eligibility requirements included: (1) must have completed a minimum of two semesters as a full-time undergraduate student (24-36 credit hours) enrolled in an emphasis in the Division of Design & Merchandising, (2) must be currently enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student (minimum 12 credit hours) in the Division of Family & Consumers, (3) must intend to complete a degree in Family & Consumers Sciences, and (4) must not have received an earlier award. Scholarships are awarded annually at the discretion of the organization.

WV Community Educational Outreach Service, Inc. Scholarship

Annual provides up to three awards to WV residents who are at least sophomores and enrolled in an undergraduate emphasis in the Division of Design & Merchandising. Scholarships are awarded annually at the discretion of the organization.
