Endowed, Non-endowed & Pass-thru Scholarships

Alan Lindamood Wildlife Management Scholarship

This fund shall provide scholarships for West Virginia residents who are students enrolled at WVU as pre-majors or majors in Wildlife and Fisheries Resources program in the Davis College of Agriculture, Forestry and Consumer Sciences. Recipients shall demonstrate academic promise and financial need, and shall not be a recipient of the PROMISE Scholarship. A student who is a recipient one year is eligible for consideration in any other year. No expenditures will be made until the annual gift is received. Funds shall be awarded in the name of Alan Lindamood.

Allen W. Goodspeed Forestry Scholarship

Preference will be given to students identified for aid through the WVU Scholars Program who also meet the requirements of this fund. The scholarship recipient shall be a regularly enrolled undergraduate student in the Division of Forestry & Natural Resources of the WVU College of Agriculture, Forestry & Consumer Sciences. The recipient shall demonstrate a) need for financial assistance and b) high academic promise as determined by appropriate officials of the Office of Student Financial Aid in consultation with the Division of Forestry & Natural Resources. The recipient will be eligible to maintain at the conclusion of each academic year as long as they maintain full time enrollment. The scholarship may be renewable for up to four years of study if the recipient meets all the criteria stated above.

Bartlett Tree Foundation Inc. Scholarship

Up to two undergraduate scholarships will be awarded to promising students majoring in forestry and/or horticulture who have a genuine interest in a career in Arboriculture. Evidence of interest may consist of courses, internships, work experience or special projects in these fields. Undergraduate students from sophomore to rising seniors may be considered. Recipients must demonstrate academic achievement, as measured by a minimum 2.75 GPA. A student who is a recipient in one year is eligible for consideration in any succeeding year that funding is available as long as they continue to meet eligibility requirements. Recipients shall be determined by the Scholarship and Awards Committee of the WVU Davis College Division of Forestry & Natural Resources subject to approval by appropriate officials in the WVU Office of Student Financial Aid. Two scholarships of at least \$1,000 will be awarded for a period of one year with half of the award available for the first academic semester. The remainder of the award will be presented for the second academic semester once it has been determined that the recipient continues to maintain the minimum GPA. No expenditures will be made until the annual gift is received.

Chingos Foundation Scholarship

A maximum of two undergraduate scholarships or one graduate scholarship for high school graduates enrolled as a major in Environmental Protection or in Wildlife Science or Fisheries Science in the Wildlife and Fisheries Resources Program of the WVU Davis College of Agriculture, Forestry & Consumer Sciences. First consideration shall be given to students in the WVU Scholars Program. Recipients shall demonstrate academic promise by achieving and maintaining a cumulative GPA of 3.00. A student who is a recipient one year is eligible for consideration in any other year. Recipients shall be determined by the appropriate officials in the College in consultation with the WVU Office of Student Financial Aid. Scholarships shall be awarded in the name of The Chingos Foundation.

Christian B. Koch Wood Industries Scholarship

Recipients shall be selected from those candidates enrolled in wood industries program and maintain an active membership with of the WVU Chapter of the Forest Products Research Society. The recipient shall be a full time student of junior or senior rank and/or a graduate student. Must demonstrate financial need and have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Recommendations shall be accepted by the Office of Financial Aid yearly from the then Club Advisor.

E.P. & W.C. Percival Scholarship

Annual scholarship supporting students enrolled within the Division of Forestry & Natural Resources. No expenditures will be made until the annual gift is received.

Forestry Endowment Fund

Annual scholarship supporting students enrolled within the Division of Forestry & Natural Resources. No expenditures will be made until the annual gift is received.

George Myles Scholarship

Annual scholarship supporting students enrolled within the Division of Forestry & Natural Resources. No expenditures will be made until the annual gift is received.

Howard D. Bennett / AHMI Scholarship

Open to all students enrolled within the Division of Forestry & Natural Resources. The recipients must be in good academic standing.

Howard Berthy Scholarship

This scholarship supports undergraduate students majoring in forestry who have demonstrated a satisfactory academic average.

SCIF Sables C.J. McElroy Hunting Heritage Scholarship

At least one undergraduate scholarship per academic year in accordance with the following criteria: Recipient must be a United States citizen. First preference will be given to female undergraduate students attending WVU who are in their junior or senior year and pursuing a course study leading to a B.A. or B.S. degree in the field of wildlife management or wildlife sciences. Recipient must demonstrate financial need as defined by University policies. Recipient must take at least one class that incorporates a positive hunting message as part of its curriculum as determined by the Director of the Division of Forestry & Natural Resources. Recipient must have a 3.0 GPA or better to be eligible for and/or retain a scholarship award. Award recipients are expected to attend one SCI First for Hunters Convention (preferable in their junior year).

Virgil W & James C Spitzer Scholarship

Annually scholarships will be awarded to undergraduate students enrolled in the Division of Forestry & Natural Resources who plan to enter a career in forestry or conservation. The recipients shall be a) from the upper one-third of their high school graduating class, b) of good character and c) recommended by their high school principal. The Director of the Division of Forestry & Natural Resources and a representative of the WVU Foundation shall select the student or students to receive this award.

WVU Forestry Alumni Association Scholarship

Annual scholarship supporting students enrolled within the Division of Forestry & Natural Resources. No expenditures will be made until the annual gift is received.
