RGS Associates Scholarship IHO Clifford Collier

The purpose of this scholarship shall be to provide recognition and financial assistance to students enrolled in Landscape Architecture or its successor program within the Division of Resource Management in the WVU Davis College of Agriculture, Forestry and Consumer Sciences. Consideration for this scholarship shall be given to a full-time undergraduate student who is completing their second or third year, is enrolled in the Landscape Architecture program, is a Pennsylvania resident, and has maintained a 2.75 or better grade point average. Priority shall be given to a student interested in pursuing professional practice with a land development focus. Recipients of this scholarship shall be selected by faculty within the Landscape Architecture program and Dean of the College in accordance with the customary scholarship review and award process. It is the Donor's intent that the amount of this grant shall be \$1,000 annually awarded to one student. Any available monies not awarded in a particular year shall be added to funds available for the succeeding year.

Armentrout Agriculture & Forestry Endowed Scholarship

Recipients will be selected by the WVU Davis College of Agriculture, Forestry & Consumer Sciences Aid and Grants Committee. The recipient will be awarded \$500.00 per academic year. The scholarship will be awarded to a student in the Division of Resource Management majoring in agricultural economics or agribusiness management.

Butler, Kelly, McGhee & Lawrence A&F Endowed Scholarship

The recipients shall be regularly enrolled undergraduate students majoring in Agricultural & Environmental Education. Candidates should demonstrate high academic promise and financial need as determined by the College Grants and Aid Committee in consultation with the WVU Office of Financial Aid. Recipients of these scholarships so provided shall be selected in accordance with the criteria stated above and awarded in the name of the honorees, Drs. Butler, Kelly, McGhee and Lawrence; individuals who played a vital role in shaping agricultural education in West Virginia.

Jack Paules Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is designated for regularly enrolled third and/or fourth year students majoring in Landscape Architecture in the WVU Davis College of Agriculture, Forestry & Consumer Sciences.
