This tenure track appointment charges me to continue the work I started in the teaching and service heavy Visiting position (below), with the addition of developing a research agenda on green buildings and evidence-based design as related to health care in rural environments.

### 8/14-pres **Adjunct Professor, WVU School of Public Health; Health Policy, Management & Leadership**

In this capacity I have been involved with engaging medical residents in a deeper understanding of the goals of green building and the relationships between buildings and human health (via Grand Round presentations). I have also worked with 4<sup>th</sup> year medical students on developing a basic understanding of the evidence-based design literature. I am currently working with the WVU Health Sciences Technology Academy to engage future health care professionals in basic field research on design elements that present barriers to patient participation in the rural health care facility setting.

### 10/07-12/13 **Visiting Assistant Professor, Division of Design & Merchandising**

In this position, 50% teaching and 50% service, I developed and delivered four permanent courses on sustainability and the built environment and several one-off special topics courses for graduate students. The four permanent courses became the foundation for the Minor in Sustainable Design that I also created and shepherded through the Faculty Senate approval process. In addition to coursework, I developed and funded with external dollars a summer outreach/educational program for non-profits involved in the development of affordable housing in WV.

### 5/08 – 8/09 **Director of Sales, Green Advantage**

Green Advantage® certifies green builders nationwide. As Director of Sales, I oversaw the development of a training network capable of preparing building professionals for the Green Advantage Certification exam. Typical training partners include academic institutions, governmental organizations, other educational non-profits as well as for profit training centers.

### 4/98 – 10/07 **Executive Director, Mon County Habitat for Humanity, Morgantown, WV**

Coordinated the work of a growing volunteer organization in the construction of affordable homes with low-income persons. Directed all phases of visioning and goal setting, budgeting, fundraising, property acquisition, project management, community awareness and involvement, fiscal management, volunteer recruitment, board development and homeowner education programs. Recently completed the final home in a \$1.1 million, eight home development and the design/planning/resource development for a 13 home green

development in the same neighborhood. Spearheaded the visioning, business planning and secured startup funding for a 10,000 sqft ReStore--an entrepreneurial venture that will produce income for the housing program from the sale of recycled/donated building materials. Led the organization in the development of a 4-year organizational plan with a budget of \$2.2 million and a goal of 21 additional homes by the end of 2009. Worked very closely with a special board committee to help the organization make a successful transition to new leadership.
